**I. BACKGROUND**

On May 10, 2006, the Central Puget Sound Growth Management Hearings Board (the **Board**) received a Petition for Review (**PFR**) from Robert D. Garwood (**Petitioner** or **Garwood**). The matter was assigned Case No. 06-3-0021, and is hereafter referred to as *Garwood v. City of Shoreline*. Board member Margaret Pageler is the Presiding Officer (**PO**) for this matter. Petitioner challenges the City of Shoreline’s (**Respondent** or the **City**) adoption of Ordinance No. 398, updating the City's critical areas regulations. The basis for the challenge is noncompliance with various provisions of the Growth Management Act (**GMA** or **Act**).

On May 16, 2006, the Board issued a Notice of Hearing establishing a date for the Prehearing Conference (PHC) and a tentative schedule for the case.

On May 19, 2006, the Board received a “Special Notice of Appearance” from Ian R. Sievers on behalf of the City of Shoreline.

On May 25, 2006, the Board received a Motion to Intervene by Timothy and Patricia Crawford and a Notice of Appearance by Michele McFadden for Timothy and Patricia Crawford. The Board’s Administrative Officer notified proposed intervenors of the scheduled Prehearing Conference and indicated that the Presiding Officer would decide the motion at the PHC.

On June 1, 2006, the Board received “City of Shoreline’s Response to Motion to Intervene,” indicating no objection to intervention by Timothy and Patricia Crawford..

On June 5, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., the Prehearing Conference was convened by Board member Margaret Pageler, Presiding Officer, in Conference Room 2395, adjacent to the Board’s offices. Board member Bruce C. Laing and Board externs Kris Hollingshead and Brian Payne also attended. Petitioner Robert Garwood appeared *pro se*. Respondent City

of Shoreline was represented by its attorney Ian R. Sievers. Proposed intervenors Timothy and Patricia Crawford were represented by their attorney Michele McFadden, accompanied by Patricia Crawford.

At the outset of the prehearing conference, the Petitioner and Respondent provided the Board and proposed intervenors a “Stipulation and Order of Dismissal,” signed by both parties and stipulating that the matter should be dismissed. The prehearing conference was promptly adjourned.

## **II. ORDER**

WAC 242-02-720(1) provides:

Any action may be dismissed by a board: (1) When all parties stipulate.

Based upon the stipulation of the parties, the GMA and Board rules, the Board ORDERS:

1. Robert Garwood’s petition for review is **dismissed**.
2. CPSGMHB Case No. 06-3-0021 is **closed**.
