ORDER ON MOTION TO DISMISS

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 29, 2007, FUTUREWISE, by and through their representatives, Keith Scully and Tim Trohimovich, filed a Petition for Review.

On September 21, 2007, the Board received a Notice of Appearance from Brock Howell, authorized representative for Futurewise.

On September 27, 2007, the Board held a telephonic Prehearing conference. Present were, Dennis Dellwo, Presiding Officer, and Board Member John Roskelley. Board Member Joyce Mulliken was unavailable. Present for Petitioners was Brock Howell. Present for Respondent was Susan Hinkle.

On September 28, 2007, the Board issued its Prehearing Order.

1 On October 5, 2007, the Board received a Stipulated Motion to Continue, requesting
2 a forty-two (42) day extension signed by the parties in this matter. The parties are currently
3 involved in settlement negotiations. The Board grants a 42 day extension and provides the
4 following schedule.

5 On October 10, 2007, the Board issued its Order on Stipulated Motion to Continue.

6 On January 17, 2008, the Board received a Motion to Continue, requesting a ninety
7 (90) day extension signed by the parties in this matter. The parties are currently involved in
8 settlement negotiations. The Board grants the ninety (90) day extension and provides the
9 following schedule.

10 On January 23, 2008, the Board issued its Order on Motion to Continue.

11 On May 5, 2008, the Board received a Motion to Continue, requesting a ninety (90)
12 day extension signed by the parties in this matter. The parties are currently involved in
13 settlement negotiations.

14 On May 6, 2008, the Board issued its Order on Motion to Continue.

15 On May 27, 2008, the Board received Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss.

16 II. DISCUSSION

17 On May 27, 2008, the Board received a Motion from the Petitioners to dismiss the
18 Petition in this matter. The Motion to Dismiss informed the Board that the parties have
19 reached agreement and the matter may be dismissed. The Board was informed that on May
20 19, 2008, the Chelan County Commissioners adopted substantial, positive changes to their
21 critical areas ordinances. Futurewise believes these changes render their petition
22 unnecessary. The Board notified the parties that it had received the Motion to Dismiss and
23 would dismiss this matter if no objections are received from the parties by June 11, 2008.
24 No objections have been received.

III. ORDER

The Petition in Futurewise v. Chelan County, case number 07-1-0011 is dismissed.
