**ORDER DISMISSING  
ISSUES RELATED TO  
SKAGIT COUNTY'S  
SOLID WASTE  
MANAGEMENT PLAN**

15 THIS Matter comes before the Board upon the motion of Petitioner Friends of Skagit County  
16 (FOSC) for an order dismissing the issues in their petition for review relating to Skagit  
17 County's solid waste management plan (SWMP). Motion for Voluntary Dismissal, March 22,  
18 2005. The motion explains that FOSC and the County have resolved their differences  
19 regarding the County's efforts to adopt a Solid Waste Management Plan consistent with the  
20 Growth Management Act. Therefore, FOSC moves for a voluntary dismissal of the issues  
21 relating to the County's SWMP.

24 This case is a consolidation of many petitions for review filed as a result of Skagit County's  
25 adoption of its comprehensive plan in 1997. To manage the multiplicity of issues, the Board  
26 segregated the issues by topic and heard the related issues together. The challenges  
27 related to the County's solid waste management plan are the sole topic on which the Board  
28 has not yet rendered a decision. With the Petitioner's voluntary dismissal of the solid waste  
29 management plan issues, the only issues remaining in this case are those in which the  
30 Board has entered findings of noncompliance and, where applicable, invalidity.
