16 the matter in the last three and one-half years. The Board issued a seventh Order of
17 Continuance on October 9, 2001, through its then presiding officer, William Nielson. From a
18 close review of the records, it appears that challenges raised in the case may well have
19 been resolved by enactments of Pacific County or changes in petitioners' circumstances not
20 known to this Board.

23 The current Presiding Officer issued a letter to counsel on April 26, 2005, requesting a
24 response by May 3, 2005, stating any reasons or circumstances why this case should not
25 be closed. Petitioners' legal representative filed a responsive e-mail on April 26, 2005
