I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 21, 1996, the Central Puget Sound Growth Management Hearings Board (the Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (the **FDO**) in the above captioned matter. The FDO provided in part:

Having reviewed and considered the above-referenced documents, having considered the arguments of the parties, and having deliberated on the matter, the Board finds as follows:

1. With regard to the Policy R-108, Policy R-204 and the 1995 Forestry Lands Map, the King County Comprehensive Plan is internally consistent, is consistent with the County-wide planning policies and is **in compliance** with the requirements of the GMA.

2. With regard to Policy RL-407, which was the subject of the Agreed Order of Remand, the County is ordered to provide to the Board, with a copy to COPAC, a copy of its statement of compliance with the Agreed Order by November 19, 1996.

On November 19, 1996, the Board received from King County (the **County**) a “Statement of Compliance” attached to which was the Affidavit of Janet Masuo, attached to which were four exhibits.

On November 20, 1996, the Board received from Copac-Preston Mill, Inc., the petitioner in this case associated with the Agreed order of Remand, "Petitioner's Concurrence as to Compliance."

ii. FINDING OF COMPLIANCE

The Board, having reviewed its Final Decision and Order and the file in this case, having reviewed the above referenced documents, and having considered the arguments of the parties, concludes that the County **has complied** with the Board's Final Decision and Order.
