On December 4, 1996, the Board issued its Order Granting County Request for Sufficient Time to Respond to Petition for Reconsideration.

On December 11, 1996, the Board received King County's Response to Petition for Reconsideration (the **County's Response**).

II. DISCUSSION

Petitioners argue that the Board's decision was based on a factual error and that the Board misinterpreted one of Petitioners' arguments. The County responds that Petitioners have failed to justify reconsideration of the Board's FDO.

The Board agrees with the County. Petitioners' arguments do not warrant reconsideration. Petitioners have not offered newly discovered evidence that was not considered by the Board, nor have Petitioners identified any error of law in the Board's FDO. Petitioners have failed to justify reconsideration of the Board's FDO.

III. ORDER

The Petition for Reconsideration is **denied**.
