I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On January 8, 1997, the Central Puget Sound Growth Management Hearings Board (the **Board**) entered its Final Decision and Order (the **FDO**) in *Tulalip Tribes of Washington v. Snohomish County*, CPSGMHB Case No. 96-3-0029.

On January 21, 1997, the Board received “Tulalip Tribes’ Petition for Reconsideration,” wherein the Tribes requested reconsideration of the Board’s FDO for a number of reasons.

On January 22, 1997, the Board issued an “Order Requiring Response to Petition for Reconsideration.”

On February 3, 1997, the Board received the “County’s Answer to Tulalip Tribes’ Petition for Reconsideration of Final Decision and Order.”

On February 10, 1997, the Board received the “Tulalip Tribes’ Reply to County’s Answer to Tribes’ Petition for Reconsideration.”

II. DISCUSSION

Petitioners have not offered newly discovered evidence that was not considered by the Board, nor have Petitioners identified any error of fact or law in the FDO. Petitioners have failed to justify modification of the FDO.

III. orDER

The Petition for Reconsideration is **denied**.
