I. Background

On July 16, 1999, the Central Puget Sound Growth Management Hearings Board (the **Board**) received a Petition for Review (**PFR**) from Robert Ross, d/b/a Northwest Golf, Inc. (**Petitioner** or **NW Golf**). The matter was assigned Case No. 99-3-0014. Petitioner challenges Kitsap County’s adoption of the Suquamish Rural Village Subarea Plan and development regulations. The basis for the challenge is noncompliance with the Growth Management Act.

On August 30, 1999 the Board issued its “Prehearing Order” (**PHO**) in the above captioned matter.

On October 1, 1999, the Board issued an “Order on Dispositive Motions.” The Order dismissed four of Petitioner’s Legal Issues in their entirety and a portion of another Legal Issue. Two Legal Issues remained in the case.

On October 20, 1999, the Board received a proposed “Motion for Dismissal” (**Motion**) from NW Golf. The Motion stated: “The parties to herein hereby stipulate to and request the Board’s approval of this Motion to Dismiss the above captioned case with prejudice.” The attorneys representing both Robert Ross, d/b/a NW Golf, Inc. and Kitsap County signed the Motion.

II. Order

Based upon the foregoing stipulation, the Board enters the following ORDER:

The PFR filed by Robert Ross d/b/a NW Golf, Inc. challenging Kitsap County's adoption of the Suquamish Rural Village Subarea Plan and development regulations, CPSGMHB Case No. 99-3-0014, is **dismissed with prejudice**.

The hearing on the merits for this case, scheduled for November 22, 1999, is **canceled**.
