I. BACKGROUND

On June 19, 2006, the Central Puget Sound Growth Management Hearings Board (the **Board**) received a Petition for Review (**PFR**) from Sno-King Environmental Alliance and Corinne R. Hensley (**Petitioners** or **Sno-King**). The matter was assigned Case No. 06-3-0025, and is hereafter referred to as *Sno-King II v. Snohomish County*. Board member Edward G. McGuire is the Presiding Officer (**PO**) for this matter. Petitioners again challenge Snohomish County’s (**Respondent** or the **County**) adoption of Odor and Seismic Hazard regulations for essential public facilities.¹ Ordinance Nos. 06-024 (Odor) and 06-025 (Seismic) amend the County’s development regulations. Petitioners contend that the adoption of these Ordinances is noncompliant with various provisions of the Growth Management Act (**GMA** or **Act**).

On June 29, 2006, the Board issued a “Notice of Hearing” in the above-captioned case.

On July 10, 2006, the Board issued its “Prehearing Order” setting forth the final schedule and Legal Issues to be decided.

On August 18, 2006, the Board received a letter from Petitioner Hensley indicating that she was withdrawing from the above captioned case as a Petitioner.

On August 24, 2006, the Board received a letter from Emma Dixon, representing Petitioner Sno-King Environmental Alliance. Ms. Dixon's letter stated, "The Sno-King Environmental Alliance, SKEA, will withdraw its Petition for Review of the Snohomish County Ordinances 06-024 and 06-025." Dixon Letter, at 1.

II. ORDER

Based upon review of the Petition for Review and the materials submitted by the parties, the Board enters the following ORDER:

In light of the letters of "withdrawal" file by Petitioners Hensley and Sno-King Environmental Alliance in *Sno-King II v. Snohomish County*, CPSGMHB Case No. 06-3-0025, the Board hereby **dismisses with prejudice** the matter. All further scheduled hearings on this matter are **cancelled** and the case is **closed**.
