On May 5, 1998, the parties entered a Stipulation and Order Regarding Issues and Extension of Time for Decision. With the Board signing the Order on May 7, 1998. In that order the Board dismissed the issues in this case related to major industrial developments (Issue (6) and the portion of Issue (7) associated with RCW 36.70A.365) and extended the time for issuing a decision on Issues (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), the portion of (7) not associated with RCW 36.70A.365, and Issues (8) and (9) for 90 days and the remaining issues with the exception of Issue (6) were remanded to the Kittitas County Commissioners.

On August 6, 1998, the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 98-18 in direct response to the Stipulation and Order signed by the Board on May 7, 1998.

On August 11, 1998, Bricklin & Gendler, on behalf of Cascade Columbia Alliance, filed a new petition, subsequently numbered 98-1-0004, challenging Ordinance 98-18 and requesting consolidation of Case No. 98-1-0001 and 98-1-0004. Via letter, petitioners stated that with the amendment to CP Policy GPO 2.108, they withdrew Issues (4), (5), the portion of (7) not

associated with RCW 36.70A.365, and Issues (8) and (9).

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the issues requested to be withdrawn are hereby dismissed.

It is further ordered the remaining 3 issues shall be consolidated and incorporated into Case No. 98-1-0004.
