PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 7, 1999, Robert M. Harrison and Robert D. Jones filed separate Petitions for Review both of which included some issues related to Resolution 16-1997 and Resolution 149-1997. Between August 13 and October 29, 1999, the parties in this matter signed a Stipulation and Agreed Order of Continuance for a period of 90 days for purposes of mediation, which has since expired.

On April 24, 2000, in response to a Superior Court Order on Appeal, the Board invalidated Stevens County Resolutions 16-1997 and 149-1997.

On October 19, 2000, a conference was held with notice to all parties. This conference was to consult with the Parties to determine if there are issues that remain to be decided by this Board. The parties present at this conference agreed that the issues raised in the petition were now moot.

FINDINGS

The Board finds that the Superior Court's invalidation of Stevens County Resolutions, 16-1997 and 149-1997, invalidating the interim IUGAs ab initio, causes the issues raised in this matter to be moot.

ORDER

Now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Petition for Review in the above-entitled matter is DISMISSED.
