ORDER FINDING
PROCEDURAL COMPLIANCE

On November 2, 2000, the Board issued its Final Decision and Order in this matter finding Ferry County not in compliance with the Growth Management Act due to its failure to review the Critical Areas Ordinance designations and development regulations to insure they are consistent with the County's Comprehensive Plan.

On February 8, 2001, the Board received the County's Resolution No. 2001-06 Regarding Consistency of the Critical Area Ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan adopted on February 5, 2001.

A briefing schedule was determined and a compliance hearing set for April 18, 2001.

On March 23, 2001, the Board received Petitioners' brief on procedural compliance. Petitioners noted in the brief, "(A)ccordingly, we do not dispute that the county has now achieved procedural compliance in the matter before you. We will reserve our arguments on substantive compliance for the proper occasion."

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board finds Ferry County in procedural compliance with the Growth Management Act with respect to the Board's earlier determination that the County had failed to review the Critical Areas Ordinance designations and development regulations to insure consistency with the Ferry County Comprehensive Plan.

Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.300, this is a final order for purposes of appeal.
