ORDER FINDING PARTIAL
COMPLIANCE AND
CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

On September 25, 2001, the Board issued an Order on Motion finding the City of Moses Lake had failed to adopt a comprehensive plan or implementing development regulations. A hearing to set a compliance schedule was set for October 17, 2001.

On October 17, 2001, the Board held the compliance scheduling hearing. Present for Petitioner was Dennis D. Reynolds. Present for Respondent was Katherine Kenison.

After discussion and hearing comments from the parties, the Board finds the City of Moses Lake approved Resolution 2365 adopting a comprehensive plan on September 11, 2001 and therefore is in compliance on this issue.

The Board finds the City of Moses Lake in continued noncompliance due to its failure to adopt development regulations implementing the comprehensive plan.

This hearing is recessed for up to 30 days from the issuance of this Order to allow the Respondent to provide the Board a timetable for developing and adopting the required development regulations.

When the Respondent has provided the information to the Board, the hearing will be reconvened.
