ORDER ON MOTIONS

I. BACKGROUND

On February 15, 2002, Respondents filed Respondent's Motion to Revise Case Schedule and for Continuance and Stipulation in the above referenced matter.

On February 19, 2002, the Board received Petitioner's Opposition by Citizens for Good Governance and 100 Friends of Washington to Walla Walla County's Motion to Revise Schedule and for Continuance. The Board scheduled a telephonic conference be held on February 28, 2002, at 2:00 p.m. to discuss the matter further.

On February 22, 2002, the Board received from Petitioner, City of Walla Walla Response to respondent's Motion to Revise Case Schedule.

On February 26, 2002, the Board received Walla Walla County's Reply to City of Walla Walla's Response.

On February 27, 2002, the Board received Petitioner City of Walla Walla Second Response to Respondent's Motion to Revise Case Schedule. The Board also received Respondent Walla Walla County's Motion to Strike City's Second Response.

On February 28, 2002, the Board received Petitioner City of Walla Walla's Motion to Enforce Settlement Agreement and Response to Respondent's Motion to Strike. The Board also received from the Respondent Motion for Entry of Stipulation and Order of Agreed Remand Subject to Parties' Agreement.

The Board held the teleconference and all parties participated. The Respondent withdrew its Motion to Revise Case Schedule and for Continuance. After hearing oral

arguments and reading the briefs the Board makes the following decisions.

1. Petitioner's Hearing on the Merits Reply Brief is due **March 8, 2002**.
2. The Board will hold a telephonic conference on **March 11, 2002, at 10:00 a.m.** The parties will call 360-709-4811. Ports have been reserved for Mr. Eustis, Mr. Zilavy, Mr. Donaldson, and Mr. Reynolds. At this time the Respondents' Motion to Supplement the Record and Respondents' Motion to Strike will be heard.
3. The Board will decide without further hearing, if the County's and City's Motion for Entry of Stipulation will be granted as submitted. If changes need to be made, they will be discussed at the March 11, 2002, teleconference.
4. Prior to the Hearing on the Merits held on March 14th and 15th, 2002, at 10:00 a.m. the Board will hear Petitioner's Motion to Supplement.
