



motion, there are contested issues remaining. The fact that the C.U.S.T.E.R. Association appeared to be satisfied by the result obtained by the County's adoption of the ordinance in question did not prevent the remaining petitioners from contesting whether invalidation should be rescinded. We reviewed the record that was submitted by the County and the prior record thoroughly.

A series of challenges to the comprehensive plan have recently been filed under consolidated case #97-2-0030. As part of the hearing on the merits on that case set for November 11 and 12, 1997, we will again review the issue of whether the invalidation should be rescinded or modified. Ms. Freestone is free to request intervention status in that consolidated case.

The motion for reconsideration is denied.
