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On May 8, 2001 we held a compliance hearing pursuant to RCW 36.70A.330 regarding Mason County's motion to find adoption of interim ordinance #102-00 (October 3, 2000) in compliance regarding fire stations and their accessory structures under the County's matrix of permitted uses. The County's motion was based on RCW 36.70A.030(16). In an earlier action, on April 18, 2001, we found that Mason County's adoption of the ordinance removed substantial interference with the fulfillment of the goals of the Growth Management Act (Act).

We received notification from petitioners John Diehl and Mason County Community Development Council, and from Intervenor South 101 Corridor Group, Inc. that they would not be participating in the hearing. We received no objections to the motion. Mr. Robert Sauerlender

was present at the hearing representing Mason County. No other parties participated in the hearing.

The motion is granted. We find that the adoption of Mason County interim development regulations for fire stations in ordinance #102-00 complies with the Growth Management Act.

This is a final order under RCW 36.70A.300(5) for purposes of appeal.
