On June 16, 1997, we received a petition for review. The petition alleged that the City of Shelton had failed to act in adopting its development regulations for critical aquifer recharge areas. On February 17, 1998, the City adopted its development regulations. On March 12, 1998, we received a new petition challenging compliance of the new development regulations with the Growth Management Act. The petition (#98-2-0005) also stated that this case was abandoned.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the above-entitled petition is dismissed.

This is a Final Order under RCW 36.70A.300(5) for purposes of appeal.

Pursuant to WAC 242-02-832(1), a motion for reconsideration may be filed within ten days of issuance of this final decision.
