On May 15, 1999 we issued a Final Decision and Order (FDO) in the above entitled case. On May 18, 1999 we received a Motion for Reconsideration from Friends of Skagit County (FOSC). On May 21, 1999 Skagit County filed a Motion for Reconsideration. On June 7, 1999, we granted both motions in part and modified the FDO. In the modified FDO we stated:

“In order to comply with the Act, within 90 days Skagit County must amend the Short CaRD Ordinance to clearly state that only recreational uses explicitly permitted by the underlying zones will be allowed when the Short CaRD Ordinance is utilized.”

On July 1, 1999 the County supplied us with a copy of Ordinance No. 17494 signed on June 29, 1999 by the Skagit County Board of Commissioners. This ordinance amended Section 14.08.117 of the Interim Short CaRD Ordinance. The County stated that this amendment complied with our FDO and requested that an Order of Compliance be entered.

On July 16, 1999 we received a letter from FOSC which stated in part:

“...Friends is satisfied that Skagit County (County) has complied with the Final Decision and Order in this case by the adoption of Ordinance No. 17494 and hereby joins with the County (County letter dated June 30, 1999) in the County’s request that an Order of Compliance be entered in this case.”

We therefore find that Skagit County is in compliance with the FDO and the Growth

Management Act regarding issued raised in this case.

This is a Final Order under RCW 36.70A.300(5) for purposes of appeal.
