On April 5, 1999, San Juan County moved to dismiss the issues raised by petitioner Bahrych concerning State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) challenges. Petitioner filed a response on April 15, 1999. San Juan filed a reply on April 16, 1999. A motions hearing was held in Friday Harbor on April 21, 1999.

At the motions hearing the County conceded that the instant case was covered by our recent decision in *Citizens Coalition v. Island County*, Case #98-2-0023c (order dated March 1, 1999). Based upon that order and the long line of decisions that preceded it, we deny the County's motion to dismiss on SEPA standing grounds.
