On February 13, 2001, we sent a memo to all parties requesting responses due by noon on February 16, 2001.

We received a response from Petitioner Klein and Petitioner Bahrych on February 15, 2001.

The above-listed motions to intervene are granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The issue to be addressed by Intervenors is strictly limited to the request by San Juan County dated January 16, 2001, for clarification of:  
Whether the determination of invalidity of allowance of new guesthouse construction in rural and resource lands prohibits the issuance of a building permit for the construction of a principal residence if the property owners have previously constructed a guesthouse on the property.
2. Intervenors shall be limited to written participation and not be allowed to make an oral presentation on March 6, 2001. Intervenors shall file and complete service on all parties

(including other intervenors) by noon Friday, March 2, 2001, of any written material that intervenors wish us to consider. Intervenors may submit supplemental evidence in the form of a declaration to be filed with the written argument.
